## 1.0 Overview of Canada Council funding to Ontario in 2006-07

- In 2006-07, the Canada Council for the Arts provided grants totalling \$47.5 million to the arts in Ontario.
- In addition to grants, \$2.8 million in payments was provided to 5,027 authors through the Public Lending Right Program in 2006-07.<sup>1</sup> This brings the total amount of Canada Council funding to Ontario to \$50.3 million.
- The Canada Council awarded \$6.5 million in grants to 639 Ontario artists and \$41.0 million to 667 Ontario arts organizations in 2006-07
- Grants were awarded to artists and arts organizations in Ontario in each artistic discipline – dance, music, theatre, visual arts, media arts, interdisciplinary and performance art and writing and publishing. In 2006-07, the largest amount of funding went to music (\$9.8 million). Theatre received the second largest amount of funding (\$7.6 million), followed by writing and publishing (\$7.1 million).
- 4,622 applications from Ontario artists and arts organizations were submitted to the Canada Council in 2006-07, representing 29.5% of the total number of applications received.
- Funding to artists and arts organizations in Toronto totaled \$32.3 million in 2006-07, comprising 68.0% of the total funding going to the province. Ottawa received \$3.4 million in funding, representing 7.1% of total funding. 141 additional communities in Ontario received 24.9% of the province's funding for a total of \$11.8 million.
- In 2006-07, Ontario artists received 30.9% of Canada Council funding to artists, and Ontario arts organizations received 34.3% of the funding to arts organizations. In total, Ontario artists and arts organizations received 33.8% of Canada Council funding. In comparison, the province makes up 38.5% of the Canadian population<sup>2</sup> and 40.2% of Canadian artists.<sup>3</sup>
- As a result of the increase to the Canada Council's parliamentary appropriation (for the fiscal years 2006-07 and 2007-08) announced in the federal budget of May 2006, 172 arts organizations in Ontario received \$12.7 million over a two year period as part of the Supplementary Operating Funds Initiative.
- 200 Ontario artists and arts professionals served as peer assessors in 2006-07, making up 25.7% of all peer assessors. 87.5% of Ontarian assessors were Anglophone, and 12.5% of assessors were Francophone.

## 2.0 Statistical highlights about the arts in Ontario<sup>4</sup>

- With 52,500 artists, Ontario has nearly twice as many artists as any other province. Artists represent 0.8% of the provincial labour force, equal to the national average.
- Toronto has an artistic concentration (1.6%) that is double the national average of 0.8%, ranking the city fifth among large Canadian cities.
- 40% of the province's artists reside in Toronto, compared with 21% of the province's overall labour force. In terms of the absolute number of artists, the City of Toronto has about twice as many artists (21,000) as the City of Montreal (10,100), with Vancouver (7,300) having the third-highest number of artists.
- Ottawa (1.0%), Waterloo (1.0%) and Kingston (0.9%) also have an artistic concentration that is above the national average of 0.8%. Ottawa and Waterloo are tied for tenth in Canada.
- Barrie had the largest percentage increase in the number of artists. The number of artists in Barrie more than tripled, increasing from 105 in 1991 to 340 in 2001. The number of artists more than doubled in two other Ontario cities between 1991 and 2001 – Whitby and Newmarket (ranking these cities third and fourth in Canada, respectively). Also ranking highly in terms of growth in the arts are Richmond Hill (86% increase, eighth in Canada) and Norfolk (85% increase, ninth in Canada). In addition, there was significant growth in the arts in many other Ontario cities between 1991 and 2001, including Mississauga, Caledon and Guelph.
- In Toronto, Niagara Falls, Peterborough and Kingston, the growth in the arts labour force between 1991 and 2001 was at least 10 times the growth in the overall local labour force. In Toronto, the growth in the arts labour force was 13 times the growth in the city's overall labour force.
- Among large Ontario cities, artists' average earnings are highest in Toronto (\$34,100, the highest level in Canada), Ajax (\$31,800, the third-highest level in Canada), Pickering (\$31,000, the fourth-highest level in Canada) and Ottawa (\$29,700, the fifth-highest level in Canada).
- Among large Ontario cities, the earnings gap between artists and other local workers is lowest in Toronto (11%, the third-lowest level in Canada). The only other Ontario city with an earnings gap that is below the national average of 26% is Ajax, where artists earn 17% less than other local workers.
- Ontarians spent "\$10.2 billion on cultural goods and services in 2005, 41% of the Canadian total. Cultural spending represents 3.0% of total consumer spending in the province. The \$10.2 billion in consumer spending on culture is over three times larger than the \$3.0 billion spent on culture in Ontario by all levels of government in 2003/04. At \$851 per resident, Ontarians' per capita cultural spending is third among the provinces."<sup>5</sup>

### *Examples of Canada Council funding in Ontario<sup>6</sup>*

The Canada Council supports the endeavours of professional artists and arts organizations through its programs. The following selection illustrates the scope of the activities supported by the Canada Council in Ontario.

The **Professional Orchestra Program** awarded **Orchestras Canada (OC)** of Toronto a grant of **\$10,000** for its **National Orchestral Dialogue Pilot Project** during its 2006-07 season. **OC** is a national service operation that “works on behalf of Canada’s professional orchestral community by providing leadership and service in advocacy, professional development, communications and networking.” The project consisted of organizing, documenting and enriching five national meetings for the management staff of **OC** member orchestras. This allowed **OC** to undergo structural and governance changes, gain new members and develop dual language service delivery standards.

**Reena Katz** of Toronto received a **\$20,000** grant from the **Grants to New Media and Audio Artists - Production Grants** program to complete an audio installation entitled **The Sonic Tree Ecology Project** from December 2006 to November 2007. The project is an “interdisciplinary sound installation involving handmade amplifiers and their wood enclosures. It investigates human relationships to trees and the complicated issues involved in purchasing trees for planting in Israel through the Jewish National Fund.” **Katz** wrote that her goal is to “put tree stories from diverse personal and family narratives together in one place, shifting fixed notions of truth and encouraging dialogue.”

Toronto’s **Red Sky Performance Theatre** received a **\$27,000** grant from the **Aboriginal Peoples Collaborative Exchange: International** for an exchange with the Inner Mongolia Song & Dance Troup from July 1 to 26, 2007, in Inner Mongolia. Through this collaboration, **Red Sky** artists **Sandra Laronde** and **Matthew Pheasant** will work with **Bao Lidao**, a renowned Mongolian Indigenous artistic director, choreographer and composer to explore dance and music-driven initiatives. **Laronde** wrote: “Indigenous Mongolians share similar motifs to First Nations in Canada; this exchange will explore the similarities between these nomadic cultures rooted in shamanic traditions.”

**Harbourfront Centre** received a **\$7,000** grant from the **Jean A. Chalmers Fund for the Crafts** for the **Innovators + Ideas (I<sup>2</sup>)** contemporary craft series in Toronto from November 2006 to May 2007. The series addresses “current issues and needs within the contemporary craft field through lectures and workshops with artists, curators and writers spear-heading contemporary practice and sparking innovative design.” Presenters included Susan Edgerley and Lily Yung of Canada, Anders Rhuwald of Denmark and Steven Pozel of Australia. Through the series, **Harbourfront Centre** hopes to examine and foster a sense of identity for Canadian craft in an international context.

The **Multidisciplinary ACCP - Artists and Community Collaboration Program** awarded **Susan Balint** of Fonthill a **\$1,000** grant to attend Robert Ferré’s Labyrinth Master Class in Missouri and Texas in 2006. **Balint**, a first-time grant recipient, wrote: “My aim was to continue my research into the labyrinth as a model for theatrical experience. I’m interested in the labyrinth’s mythical and ceremonial roots as well as its artistic, spiritual and therapeutic applications.” While in Texas **Balint** also volunteered at Mo-Ranch where she collaborated with staff to create a self-guided sensory trail/nature walk, wrote articles for the Ranch’s press material and attended a spiritual symposium.

Vanier’s **Liaison** art magazine received **\$33,200** from the **Grants to Literary and Art Magazines** program to publish four issues in 2006-07. **Liaison** is a quarterly magazine focusing exclusively on Franco-Ontarian arts and culture including literature, music, theatre, cinema and visual arts. Themes for 2006-07 are space and art in French Canada, Americanism, the body and oral literature. For the 2006-07 year **Liaison** put out a call to university students to write articles with the goal of including new topics, ideas and a spur a critical revival in journalism. This resulted in the inclusion of numerous articles in each publication written by university students on various arts related topics.

**AfriCanadian Playwrights Festival** received **\$1,500** from the **Equity Office** to invite youth panellist **Jazz Campbell** to participate in the festival from August 22 to 27, 2006, in Toronto. The **Festival** is a “powerful gathering of Canadian and international theatre artists of African descent designed to celebrate, encourage, develop, promote and present African Canadian playwrights and their plays.” **Campbell**, a young dancer and actor from Nova Scotia, will perform during *First Drafts* a new component at the festival which focuses on youth. Campbell wrote: “My mission as an African Canadian youth is to open people’s eyes and help them see that anyone can be successful if they want to be.”

The **Assistance to Culturally Diverse Curators for Residencies in Visual Arts** program awarded **Ulysses Castellanos** a **\$30,000** to be Gallery TPW’s parallel programs resident curator from June 2006 to May 2007 in Toronto. **Castellanos**, a Salvadorian-Canadian curator, will organize a series of programs investigating digital time-based art and new media practices. While at Gallery TPW, **Castellanos** was responsible for “finding new ways to animate the work of artists. These presentation strategies and contexts included festival format, the gallery exhibition, the web-specific gallery and the exploitation of the Internet as a tool for linking communities.”

The **Production Project Grants in Dance** program awarded Guelph's **Dancetheatre David Earle (DtDE)** a **\$30,000** long-term grant for the creation of new works and to remount historical works in 2006-07 and 2007-08. **David Earle**, a choreographer, founder of **DtDE** and co-founder of the Toronto Dance Theatre, received the Order of Canada in 1996. **DtDE** will remount four of **Earle's** works entitled ***The Heart at Night, The Recitation, Frostwatch, Baroque Finale*** and ***Boat, River, Moon*** and a new work entitled ***Portraits, Mirrors and Windows***. A series of national performances is planned for 2008 which will combine **Earle's** new works with the reclaimed historical repertoire.

The **Lenka Lichtenberg Group**, located in Toronto, received a **\$2,500** grant from the **Audience and Market Development Travel Grants** program to perform at the Leeds Jewish International Performing Arts Festival in England from September 4 to 10, 2006. As first-time grant recipients, group members **Brian Katz** and **Lenka Lichtenberg** were able to perform songs from their CD entitled ***Pashtes (Simplicity)*** released in September 2006. The CD is "based on musical settings of 10 new poems by Simcha Simchovitch, Toronto's Yiddish poet, novelist and scholar. The recording is meant to show the continuing vitality of Yiddish as a vibrant element of Canada's current cultural mosaic."

In 2006-07 the **Aboriginal Peoples Collaborative Exchange Travel Grants** program awarded Iroquois artist **Samuel Thomas** of Niagara Falls a **\$2,500** grant to bring Akamba artist and historian **Munve Mutisya** from Kenya. **Thomas** collaborated with **Mutisya** to give lectures on the parallels of Indigenous peoples of Kenya and Iroquois peoples as well as beadwork workshops combining Iroquois and African techniques. During the exchange **Thomas' Great Tree of Peace**, a six-foot-tall, fully beaded tree that he created in collaboration with communities in Canada, the US and Kenya, was completed and installed at the United Nations Headquarters in New York in June 2007.

The **Music - Supplementary Operating Funds Initiative** awarded Toronto **Queen of Puddings Music Theatre** a **\$60,000** grant for the dissemination of its first intercultural Opera ***Vanity and the Goddess Sarasvati*** in 2006-07. Suba Sankaran, a South Indian Classical (Carnatic) singer, is the principal performer of the chamber opera created by Micheal Oesterle and Christine Unger, which includes both English and Sanskrit. The opera subverts the characters of ***Hansel and Gretel***, an original Brothers Grimm fairytale wherein "Vanity is inhabited by the mischievous Indian goddess Sarasvati, who is determined to pull two very spoiled children out of their selfish and vain ways."

Toronto's **John Jowett** received **\$20,000** in 2006-07 from the **Artists and Community Collaboration Program** to create a music program that matches professional musicians with youth diagnosed with mental disabilities. **Jowett** teaches music to students with complex mental disabilities at the MukiBaum Association in Toronto. The program will consist of various collaboration scenarios including one-to-one coaching, band and sectional rehearsals, workshops, recordings, and public jam sessions. **Jowett** wrote: "Currently, original music from people diagnosed with mental disabilities is virtually absent in the world of the arts, making the results groundbreaking."

**Caroline Pignat** of Kanata received **\$10,000** from the **Grants to Professional Writers - Creative Writing** program to work on a young adult historical novel entitled ***Wild Geese*** in 2006-07. ***Wild Geese*** is set in 1847 and chronicles the story of "Jack Byrne, who leaves Ireland at the peak of the famine only to learn poverty, disease and prejudice are rampant on both sides of the sea. The harrowing journey across the Atlantic begins an adventure that leads him from Grosse Isle, along the shores of the St. Lawrence, to the harsh life of a logger on the Ottawa River. In the bustling hub of Bytown, Jack finally discovers a sense of purpose, pride, and place to belong."

The **Grants to Dance Professionals** program awarded Peterborough's **Bill James** a **\$15,000** grant to develop the first stage of a new work in 2006-07. **James** created the piece in collaboration with media artist Valerie Lamontagne and three dancers, using Isadora multimedia software to produce "an interactive stage environment that merges with the choreography." Of the project **James** wrote, "Weather will be a metaphor to connect various emotional states to dance, sound and image. Jet-stream mapping, pressure zones, ground-level wind and ocean currents, temperatures and extreme weather inspired the process."

The **National Arts Centre (NAC)** in Ottawa received **\$110,000** from the **Theatre International Program** for its co-production of ***The Penelopiad*** by Margaret Atwood with the Royal Shakespeare Company in the United Kingdom. ***The Penelopiad*** premiered in Stratford-upon-Avon in July 2007 and will open at the **National Arts Centre's** 2007-2008 season in Ottawa in September 2007. The all-female cast is comprised of seven exceptional Canadian actresses from across the country and seven from the Royal Shakespeare Company. This production marks the first time that the **NAC's** English Theatre will perform outside North America, creating the opportunity for Canadian artists to make a significant mark on the world stage.

#### 4.0 Overall arts and culture funding to Ontario by all three levels of government<sup>7</sup>

- Arts and culture funding to Ontario from all three levels of government stood at about \$3.0 billion in 2003-04 (the latest year of overall data from Statistics Canada).
- Federal funding made up the largest share at 49% (about \$1.5 billion) followed by municipal funding at 30% (\$877.5 million) and provincial funding at 21% (\$628.3 million).
- Federal government cultural funding to Ontario totalling \$1.5 billion is primarily concentrated (83%) in three areas – broadcasting, heritage resources (historic parks/sites and nature/provincial parks) and film and video. The remaining 17% of funding is allocated to areas including performing arts (\$91.0 million), literary arts (\$81.1 million) and multidisciplinary arts (\$20.6 million). In the comparable year (2003-04), Canada Council funding accounted for about 2.85% of all federal culture spending in Ontario.
- Between 1999-00 and 2003-04, federal cultural spending in Ontario increased from \$1.1 billion to \$1.5 billion (an increase of 36%). During the same period, Canada Council funding in Ontario increased substantially from \$33.6 million in 1999-00 to \$41.7 million in 2003-04.
- The largest part of provincial government funding is primarily concentrated (85%) in three areas, libraries, heritage resources and broadcasting at \$535.6 million. However, the provincial government also allocated funds to performing arts (\$35.6 million), multidisciplinary arts (\$20.9 million) and arts education (\$15.3 million).

## 5.0 Detailed tables of Canada Council funding to Ontario

### *Canada Council for the Arts funding to Ontario*

- Since 1999-00, Canada Council funding to Ontario has increased, rising from \$33.6 million to \$47.5 million in 2006-07 (an increase of 41.52%).
- Grants to Ontario as a percentage of total Canada Council funding slightly varied in the past eight fiscal years, going from 32.37% to 34.51%. At 33.75% in 2006-07, it has been very stable for the fifth year in a row.

**Grant applications from Ontario**

- For the third consecutive year since 1999-00 the total number of grant applications from Ontario artists and arts organizations is below 30%. Representing 29.51% of total Canada Council grant applications in 2006-07, Ontario's share of grant applications is considerably below its share of population (38.47%) and its share of artists (40.20%) – see Table 7.

**Ontario – Various comparisons with other provinces<sup>8</sup>**

- Ontario is in eighth place in terms of its level of Canada Council funding on a per capita basis per province at \$3.91. Ontario ranks first in terms of its share of funding. Its share of funding is higher than its share of grant applications and significantly lower than the province's percentage share of population and percentage share of artists.
