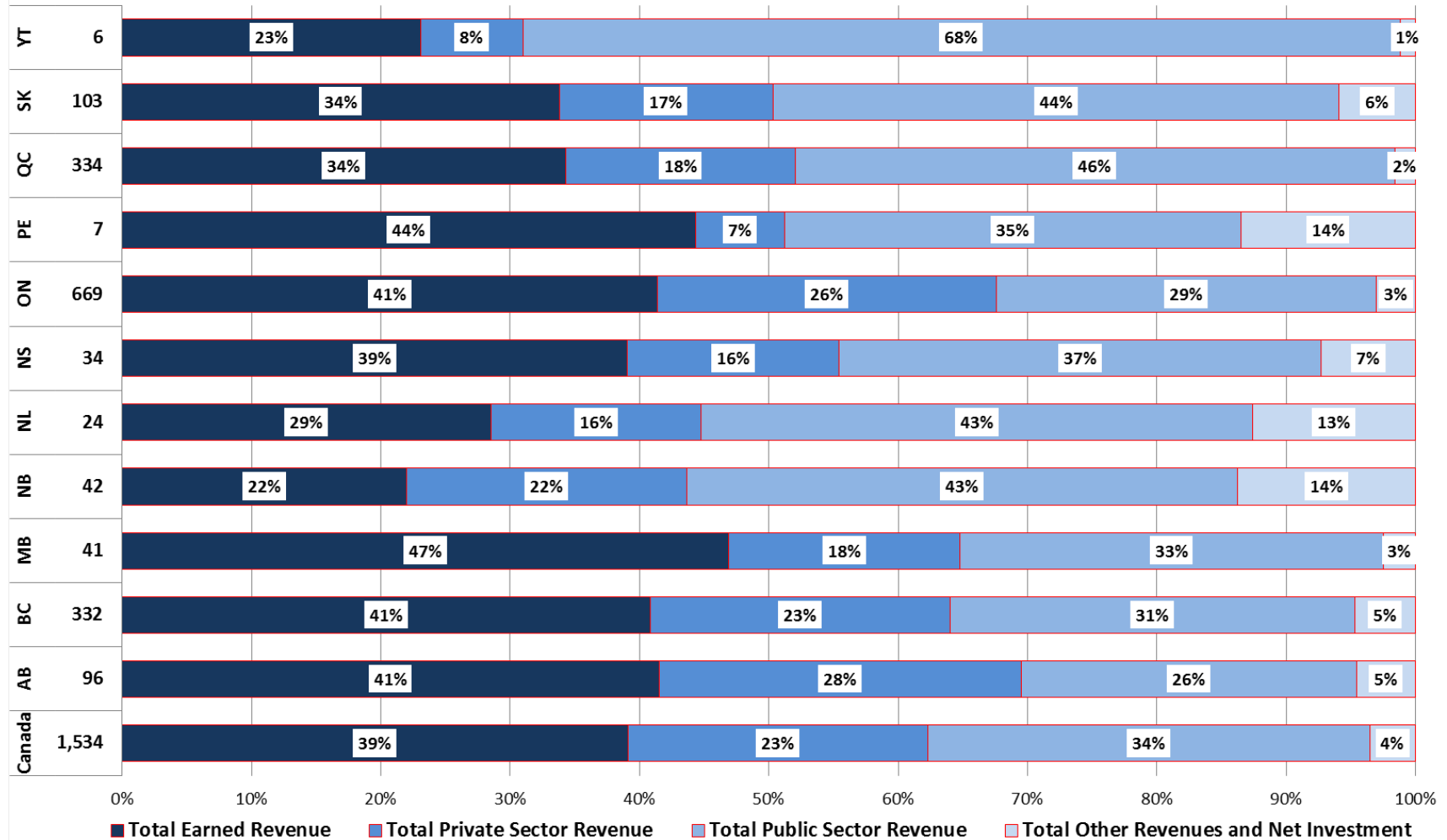

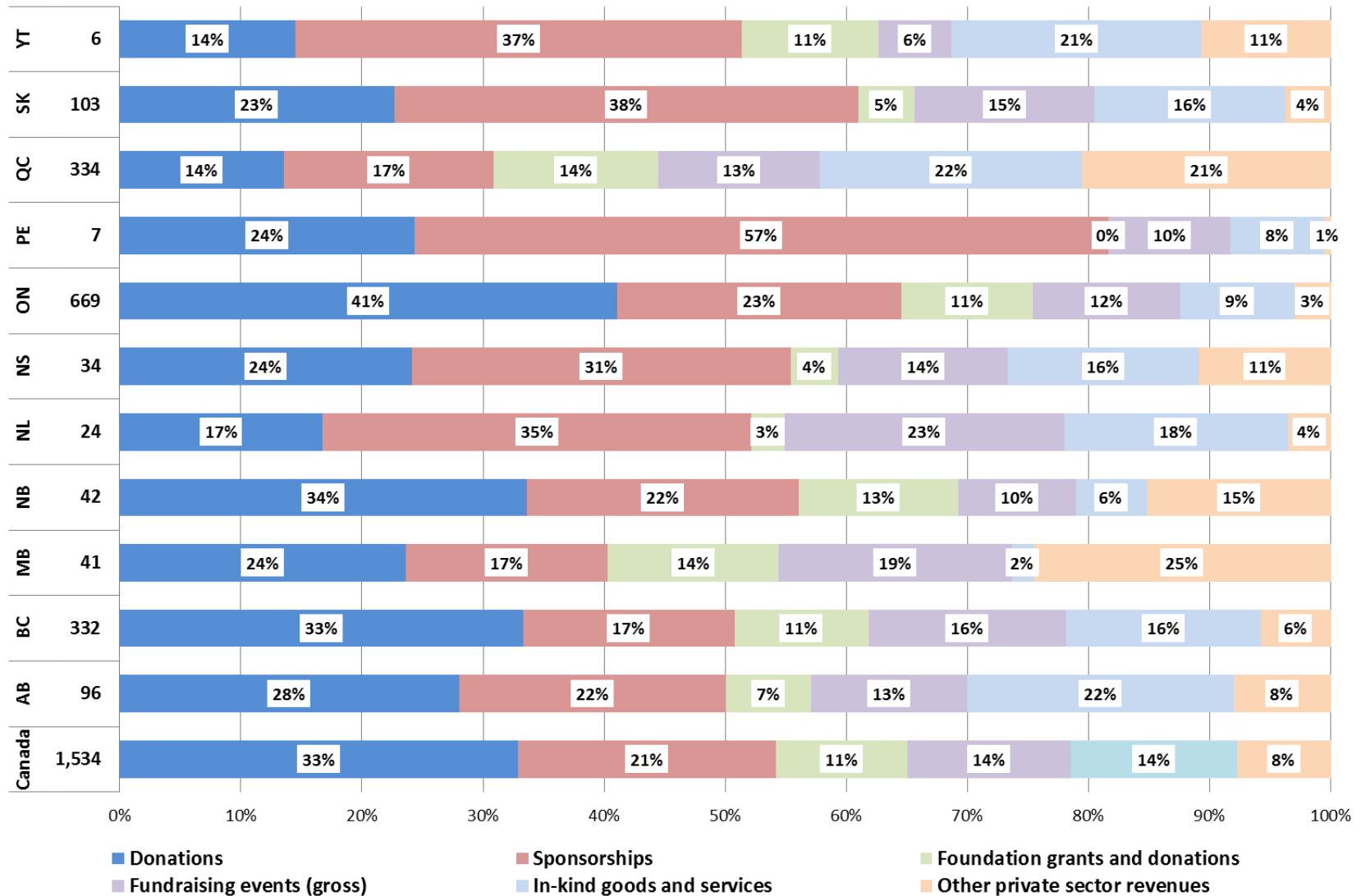

2012 - 13 locked CADAC data

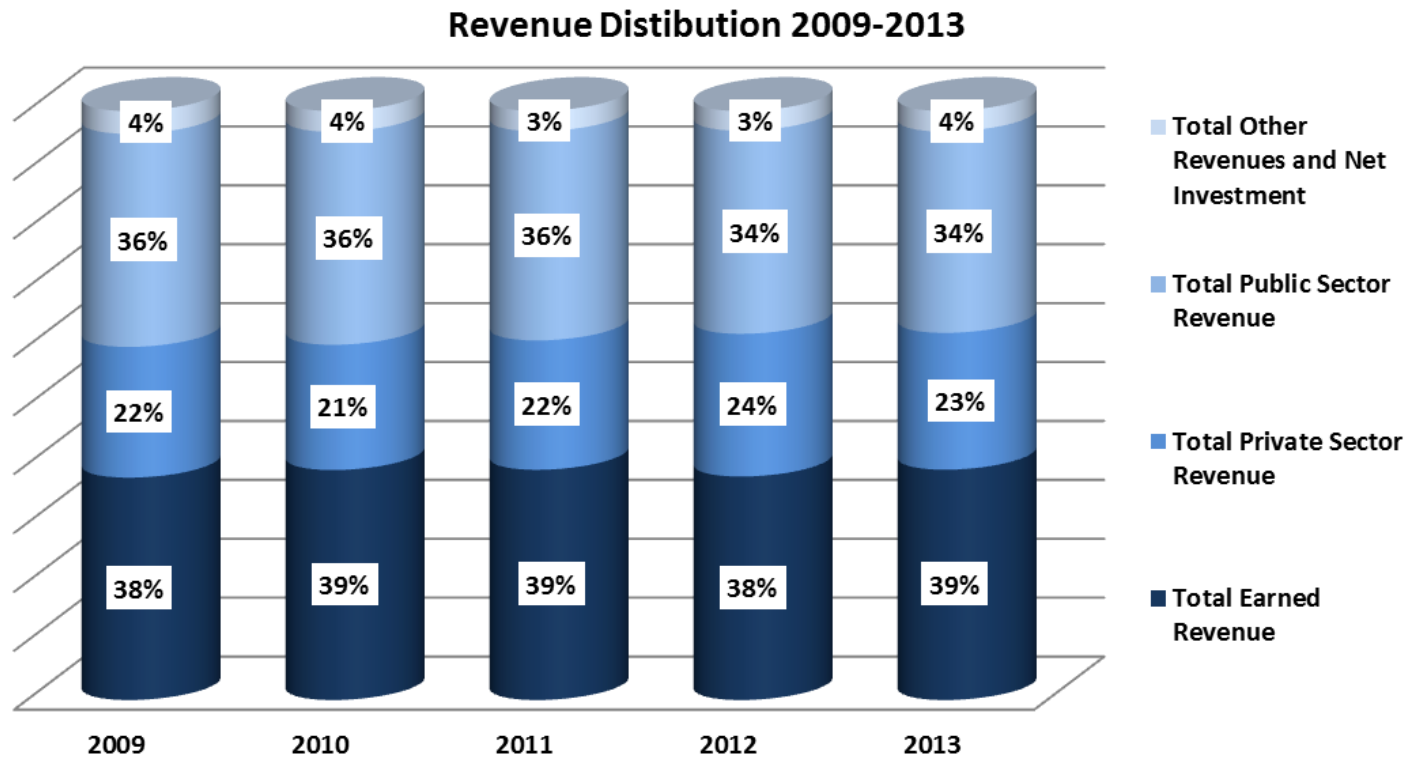


Breakdown of Private Revenues by Source and Province, *2012-13 locked CADAC data*

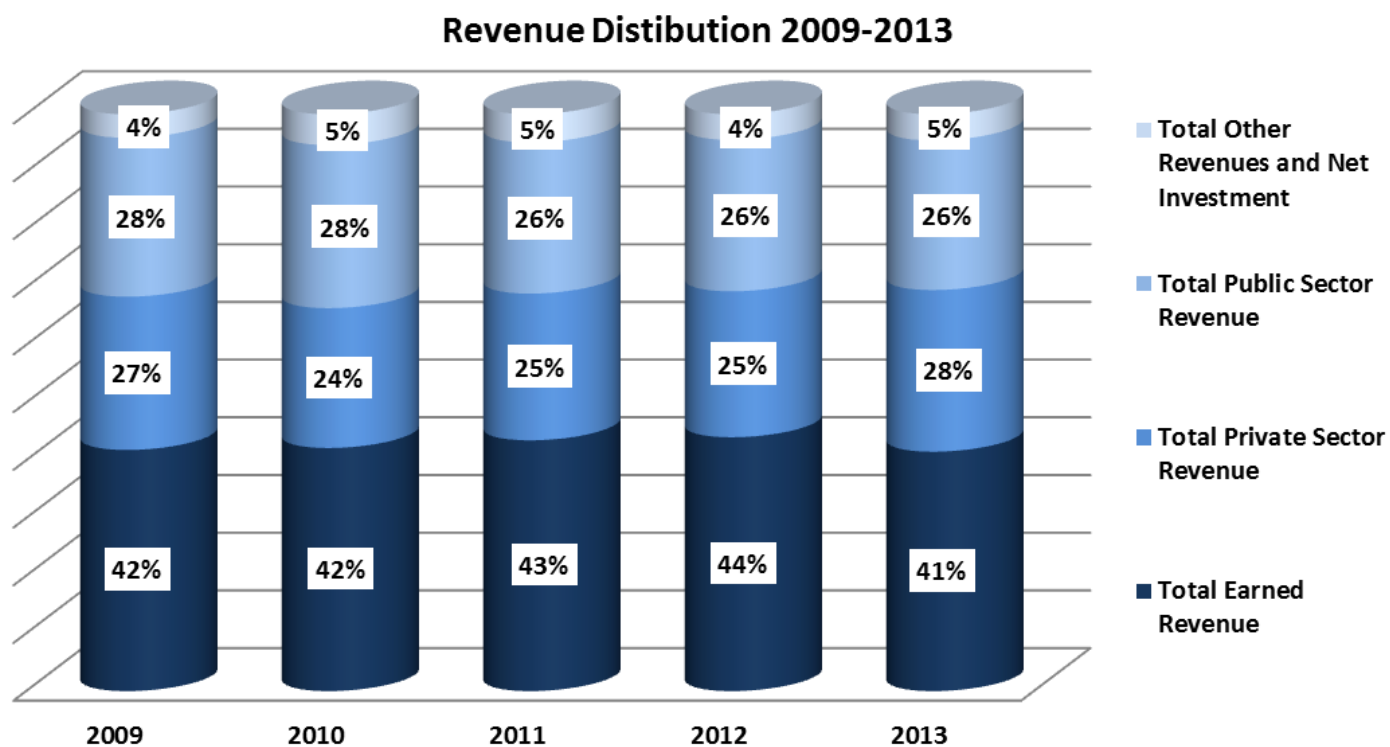

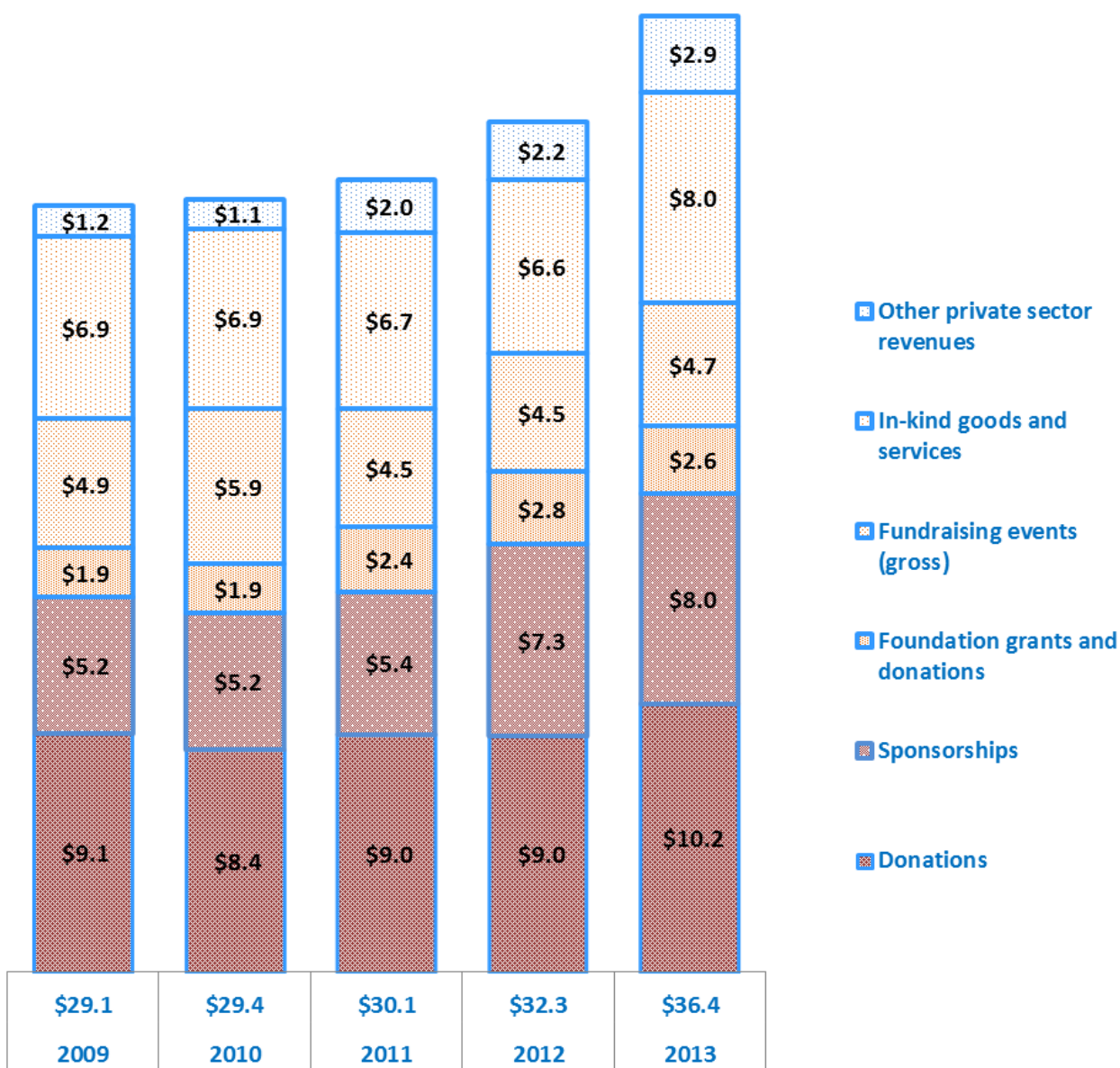

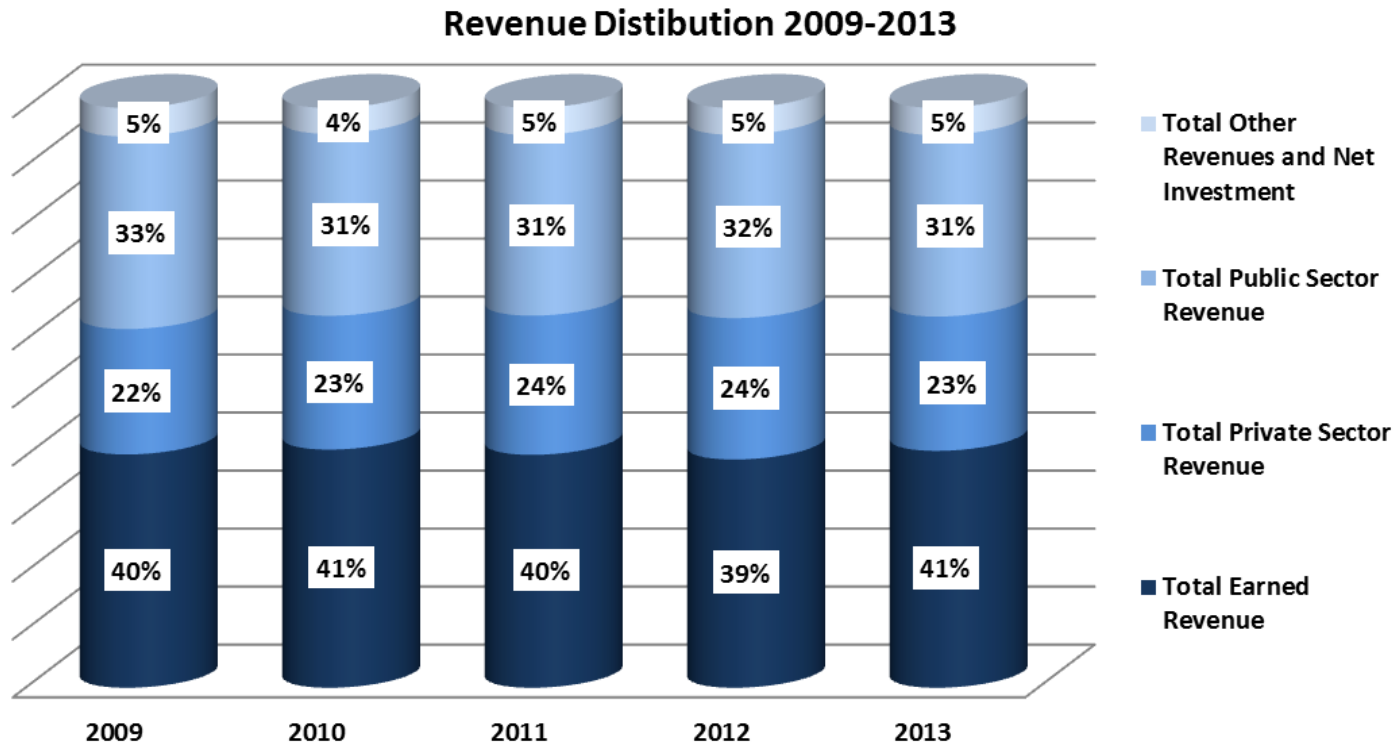

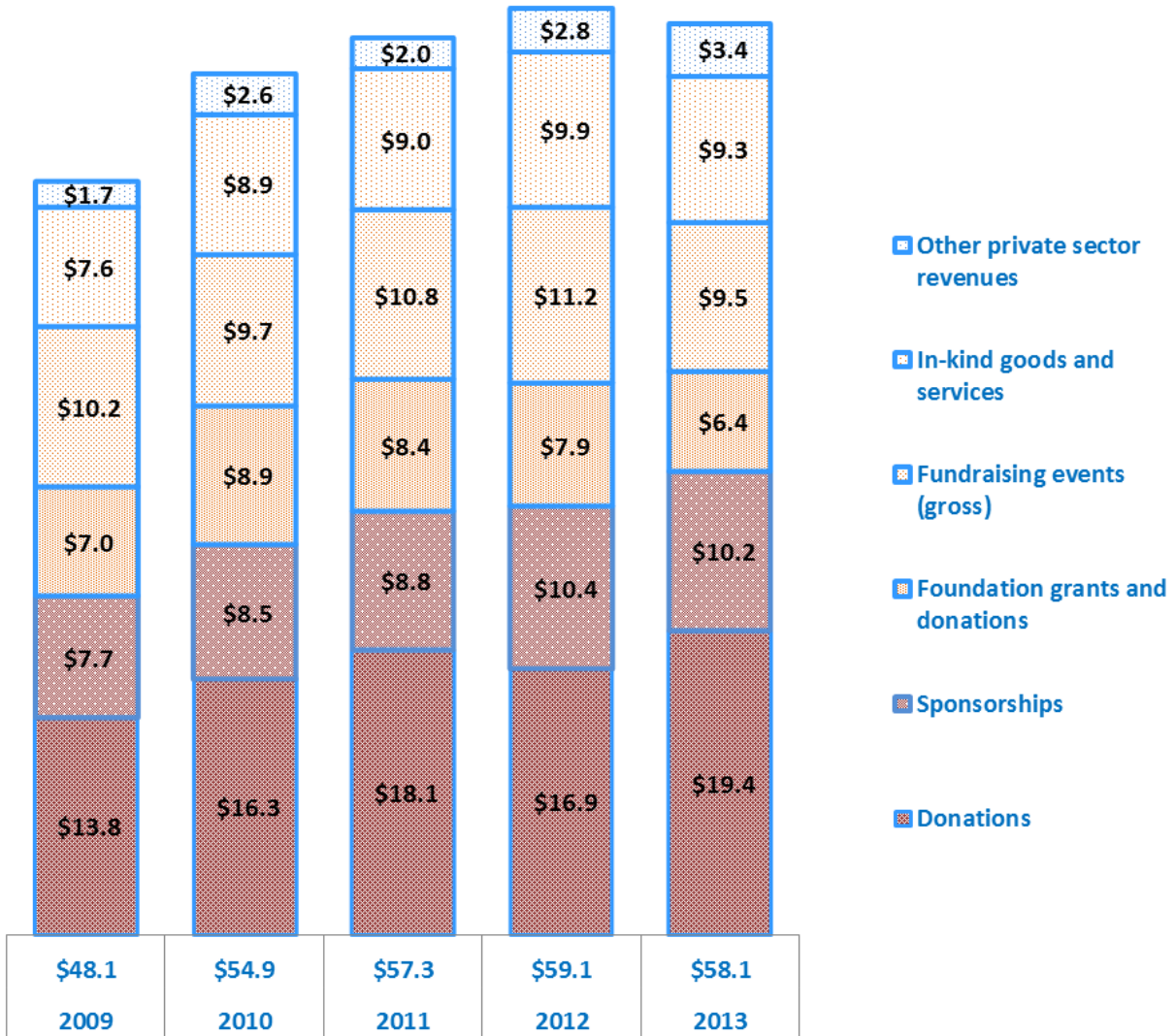

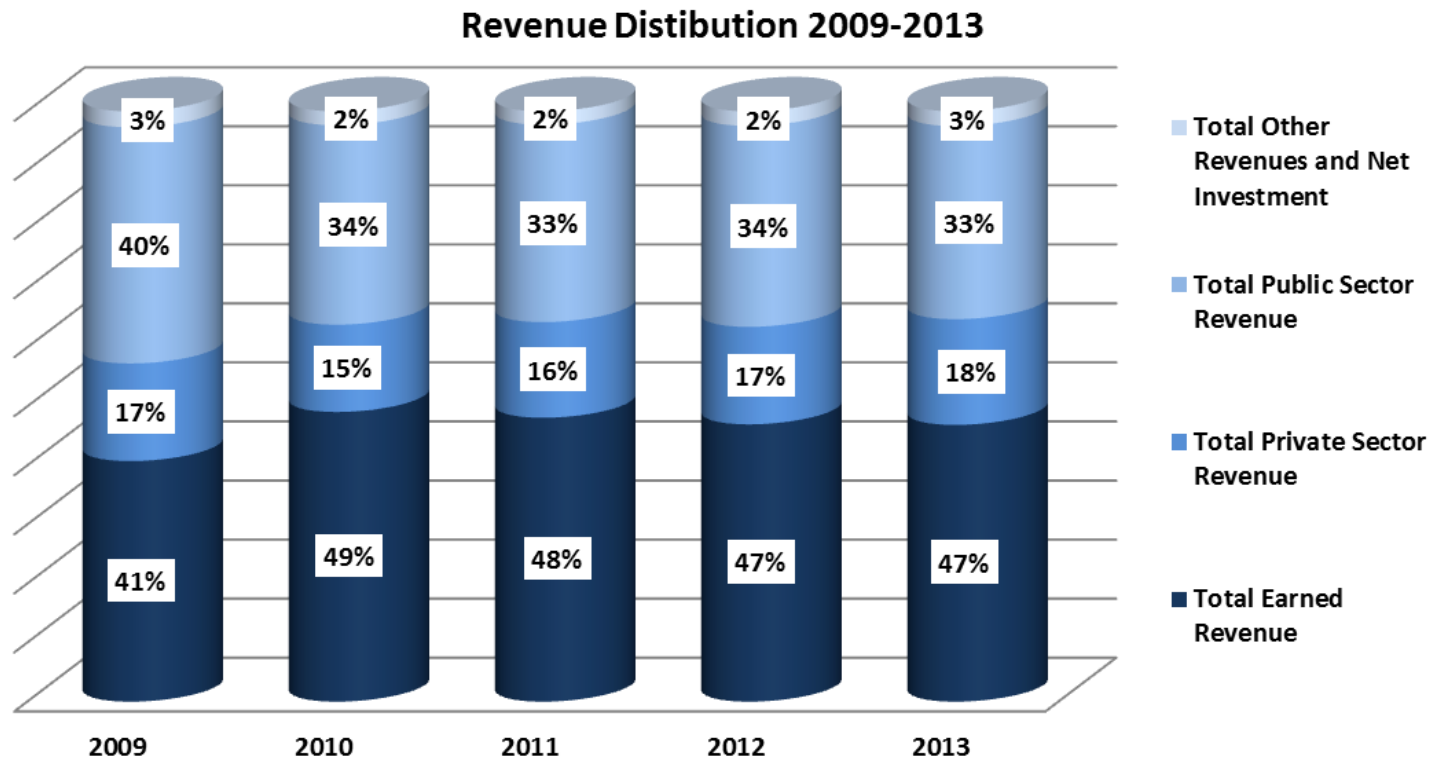

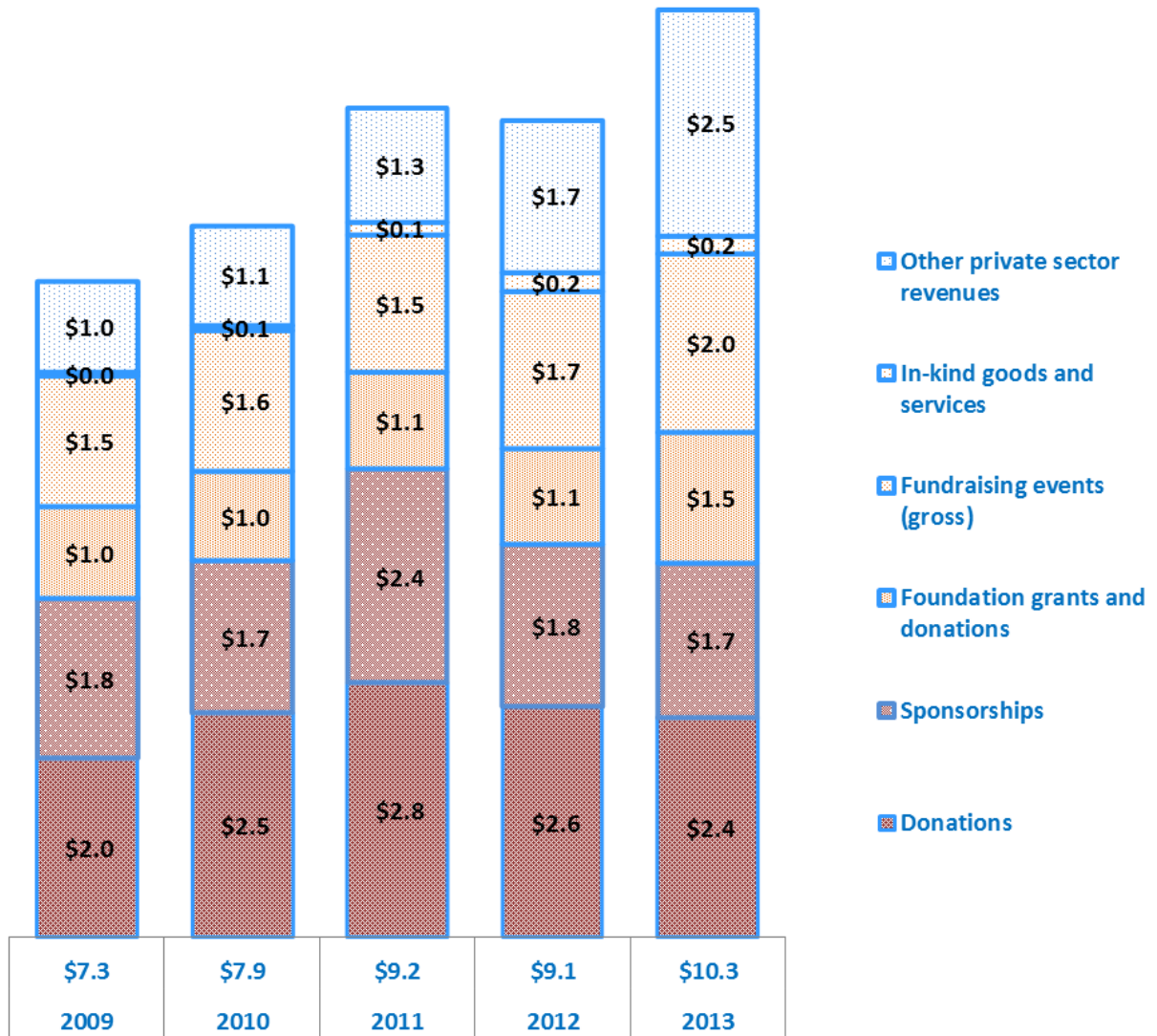

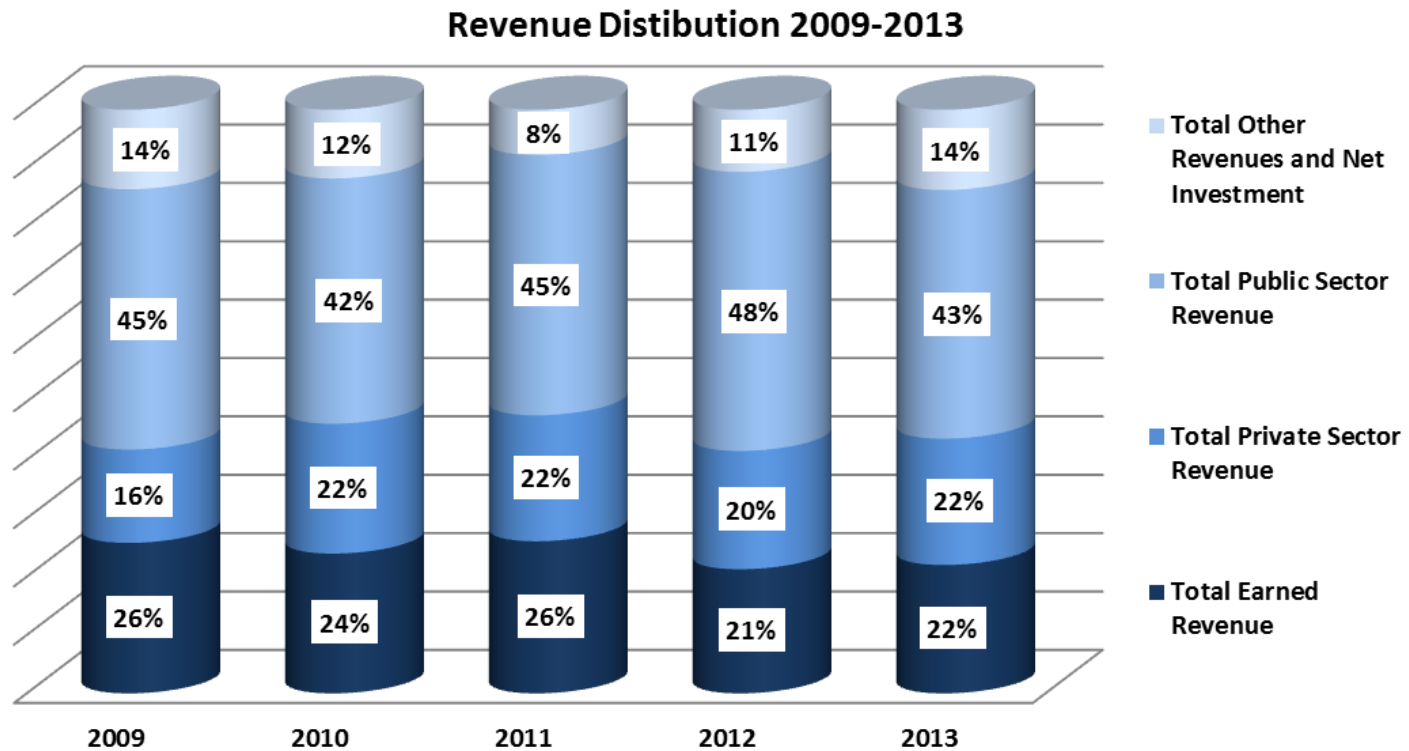

2009 - 2013 locked CADAC data, in \$millions



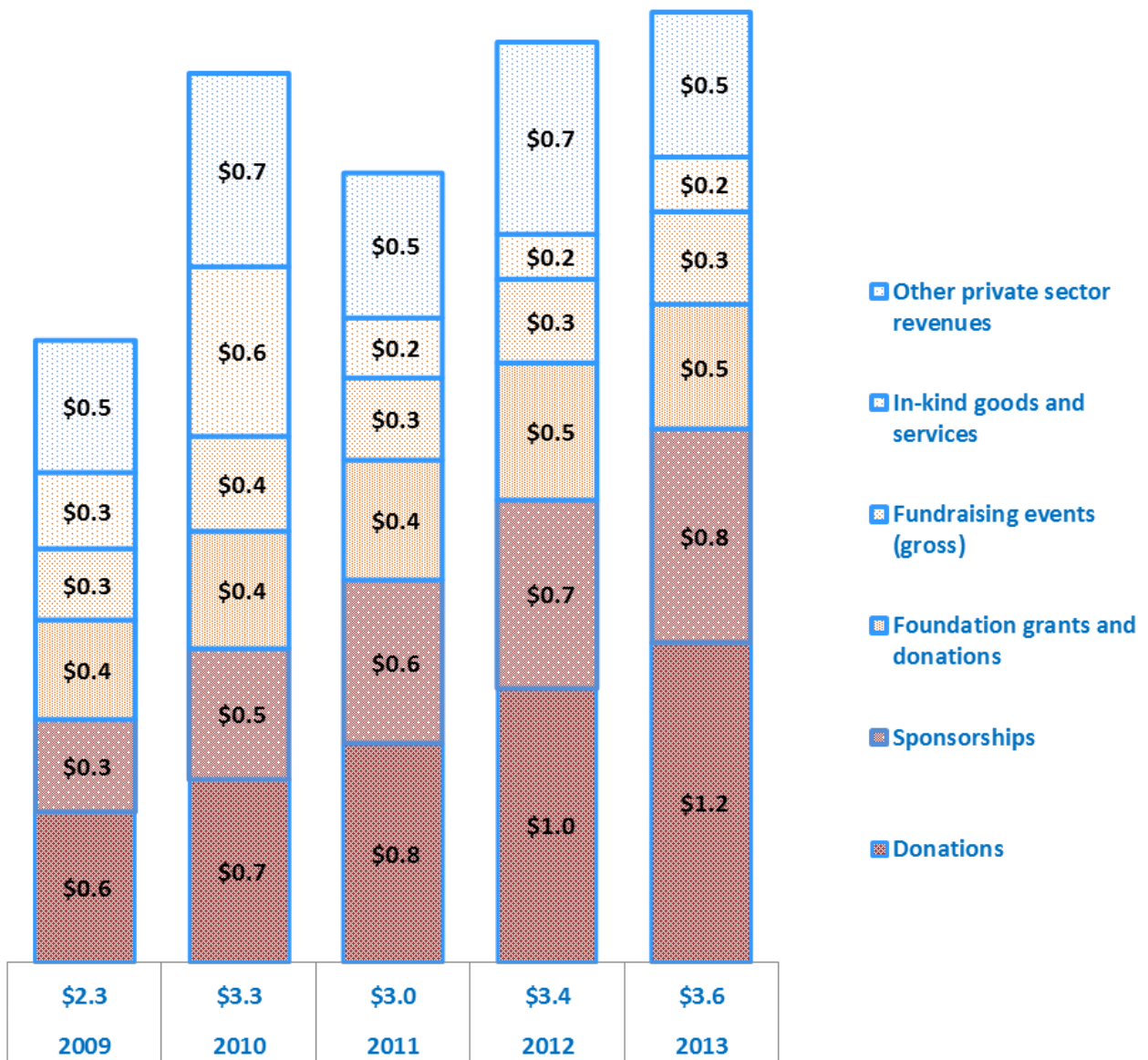

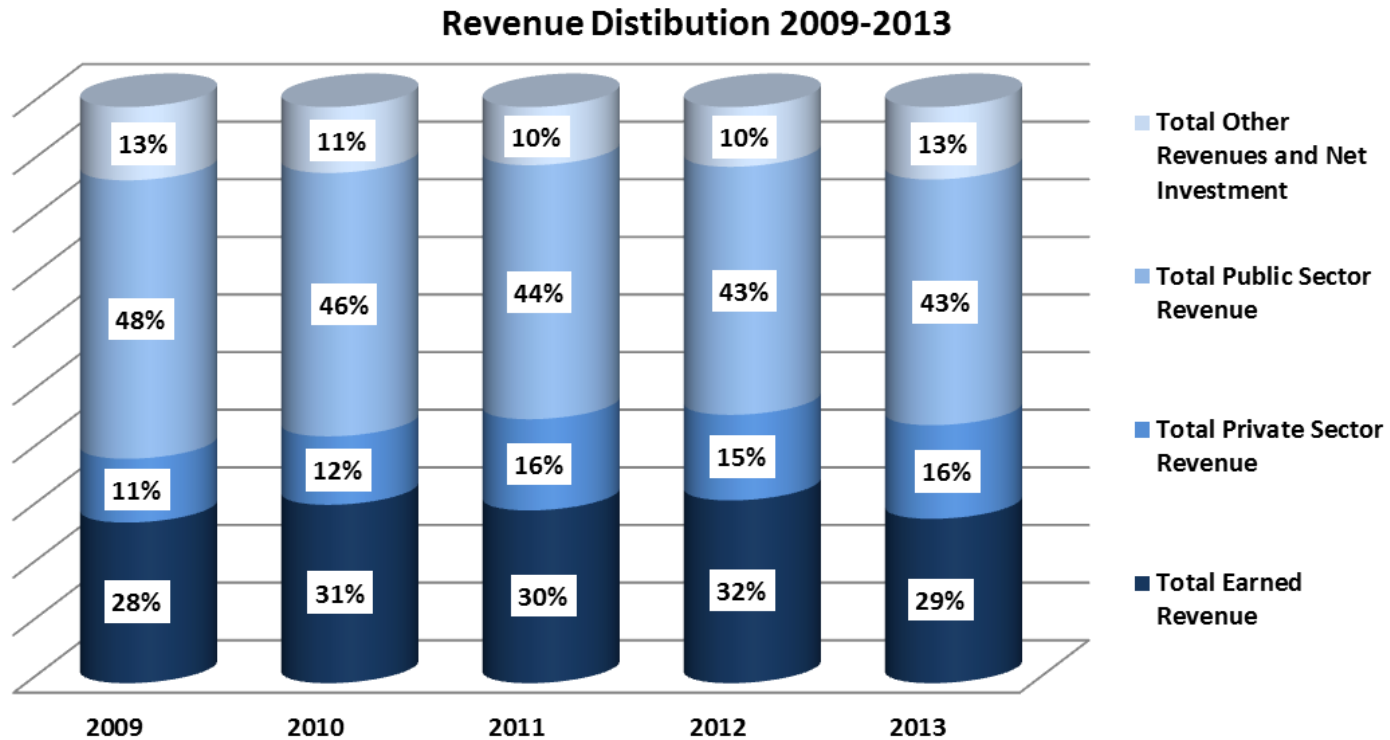

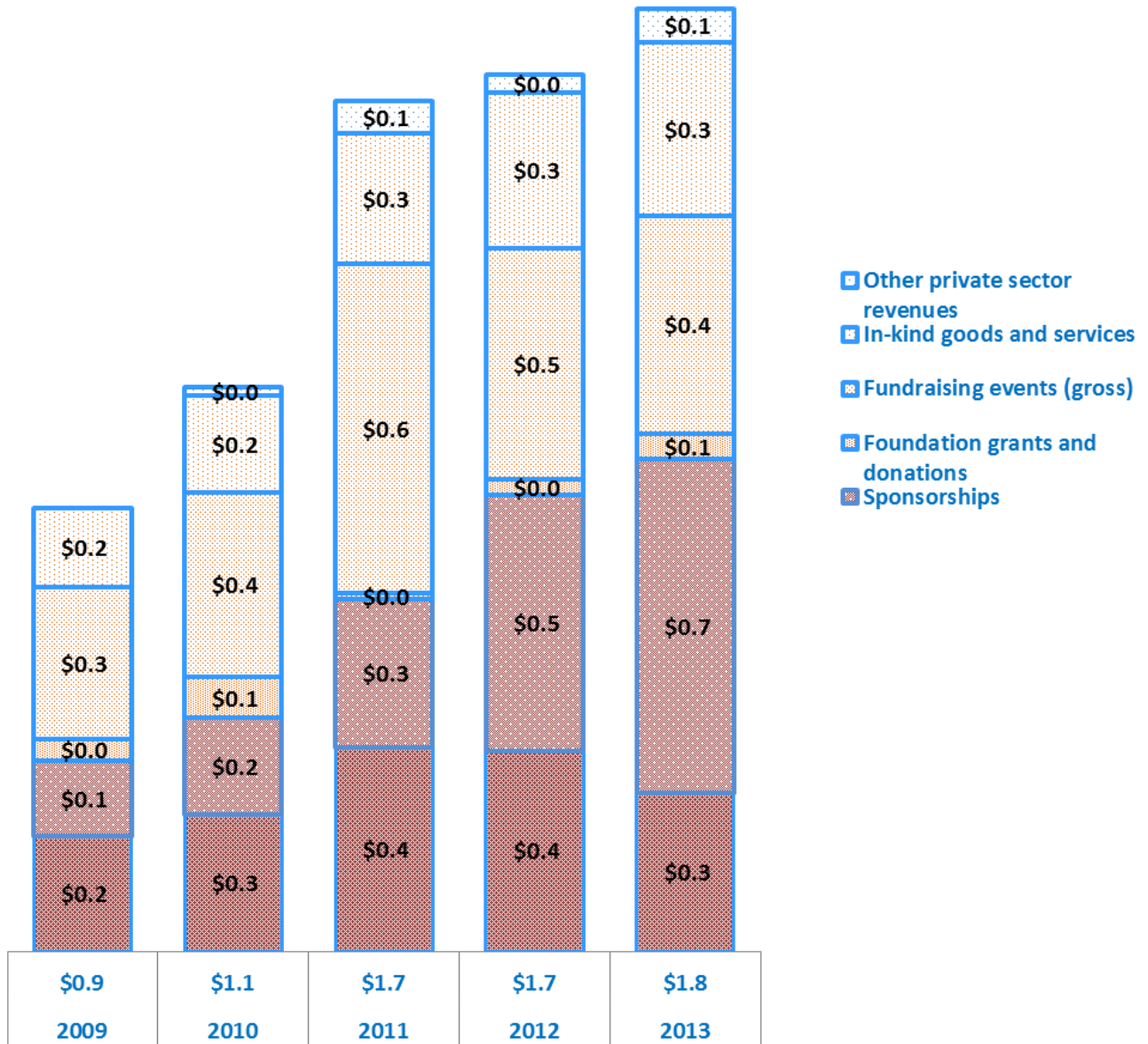

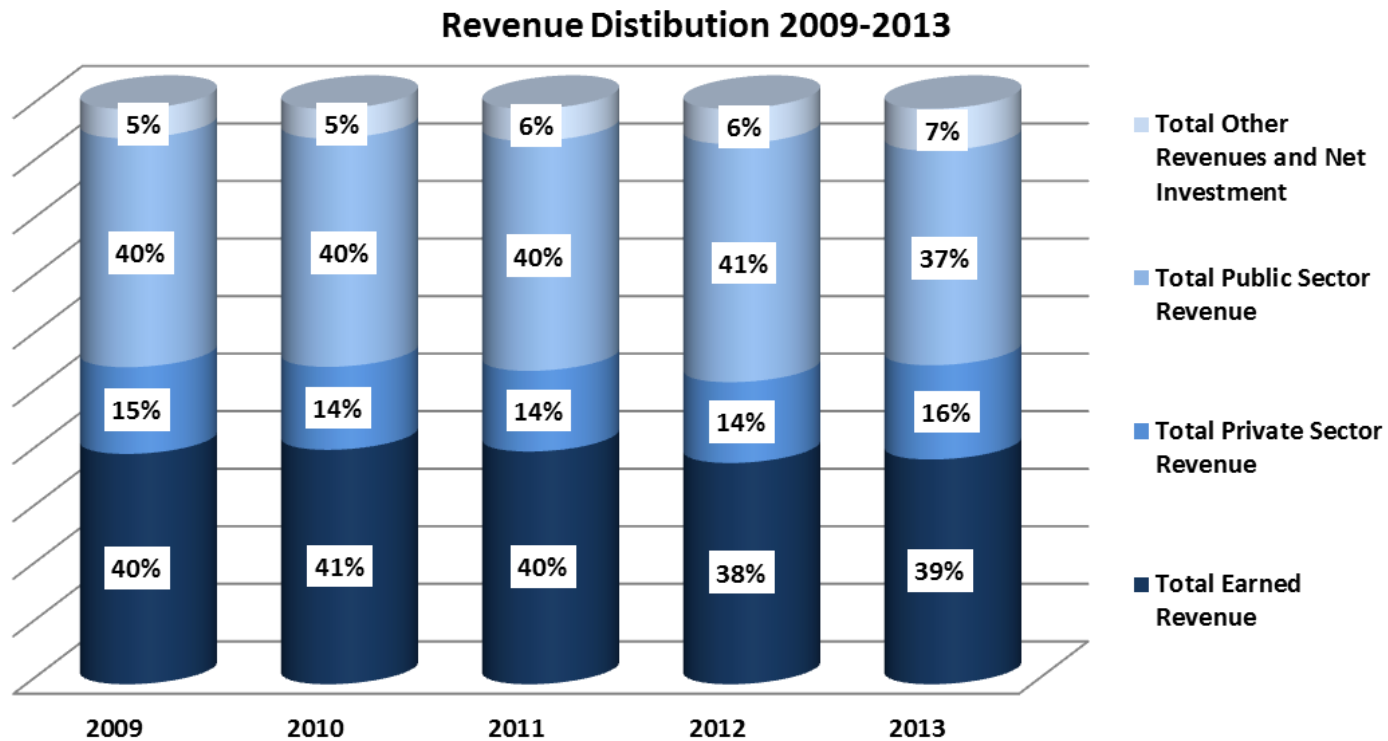

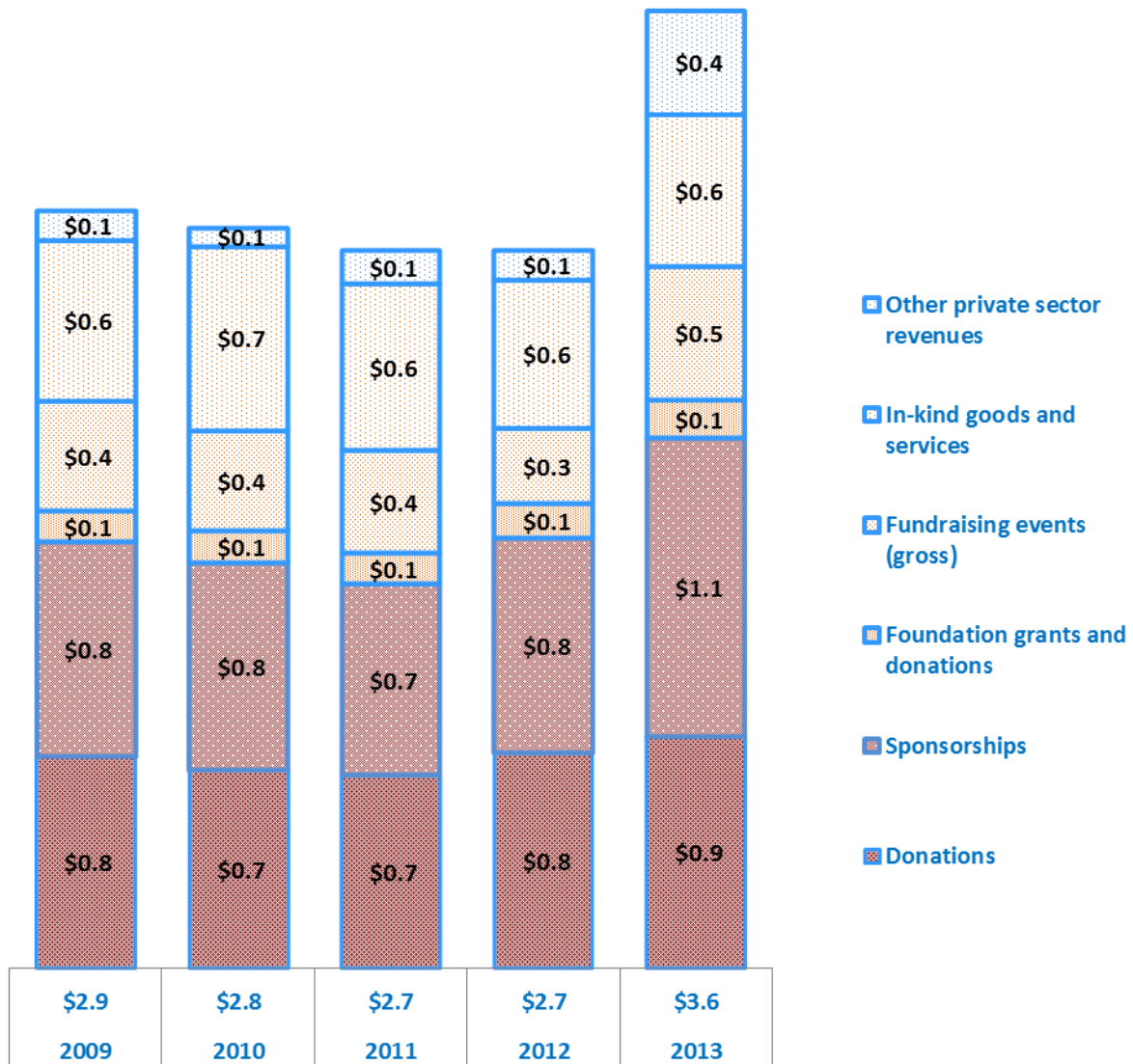

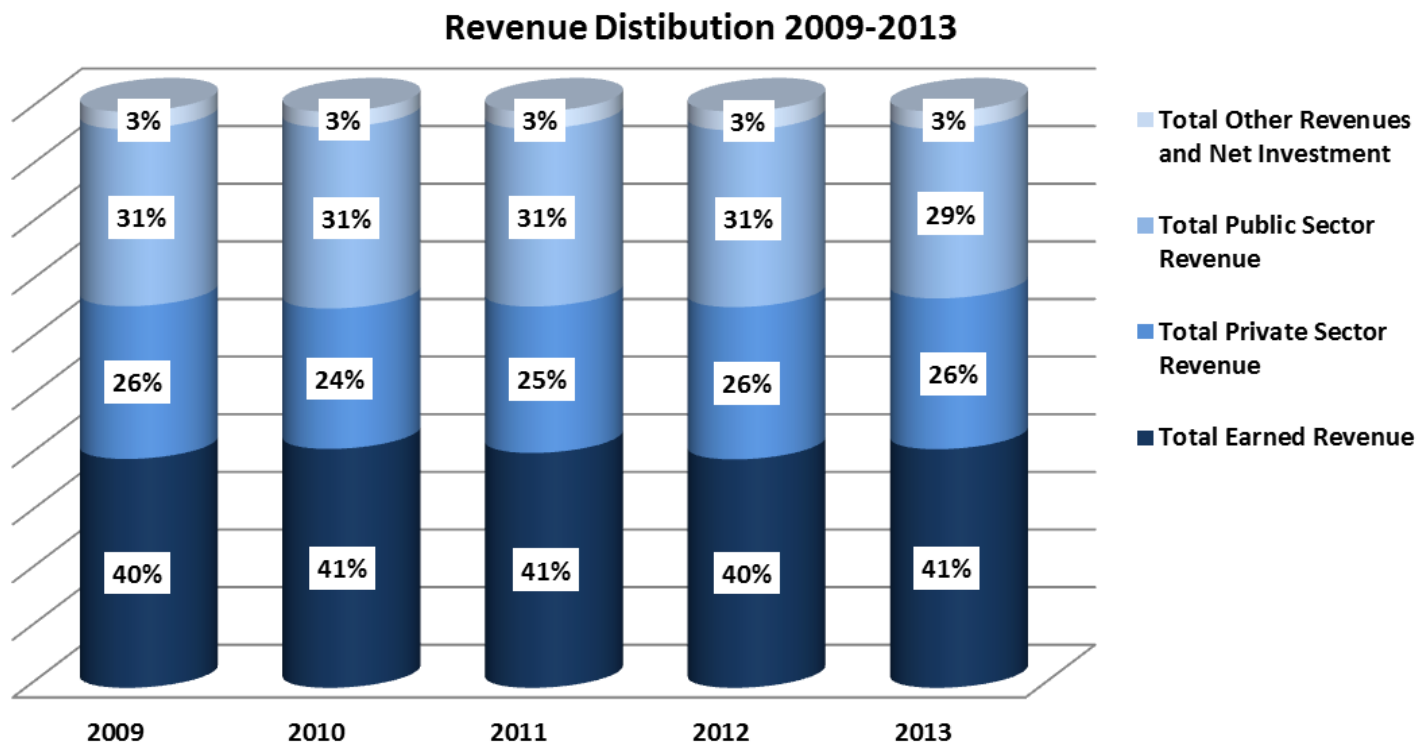

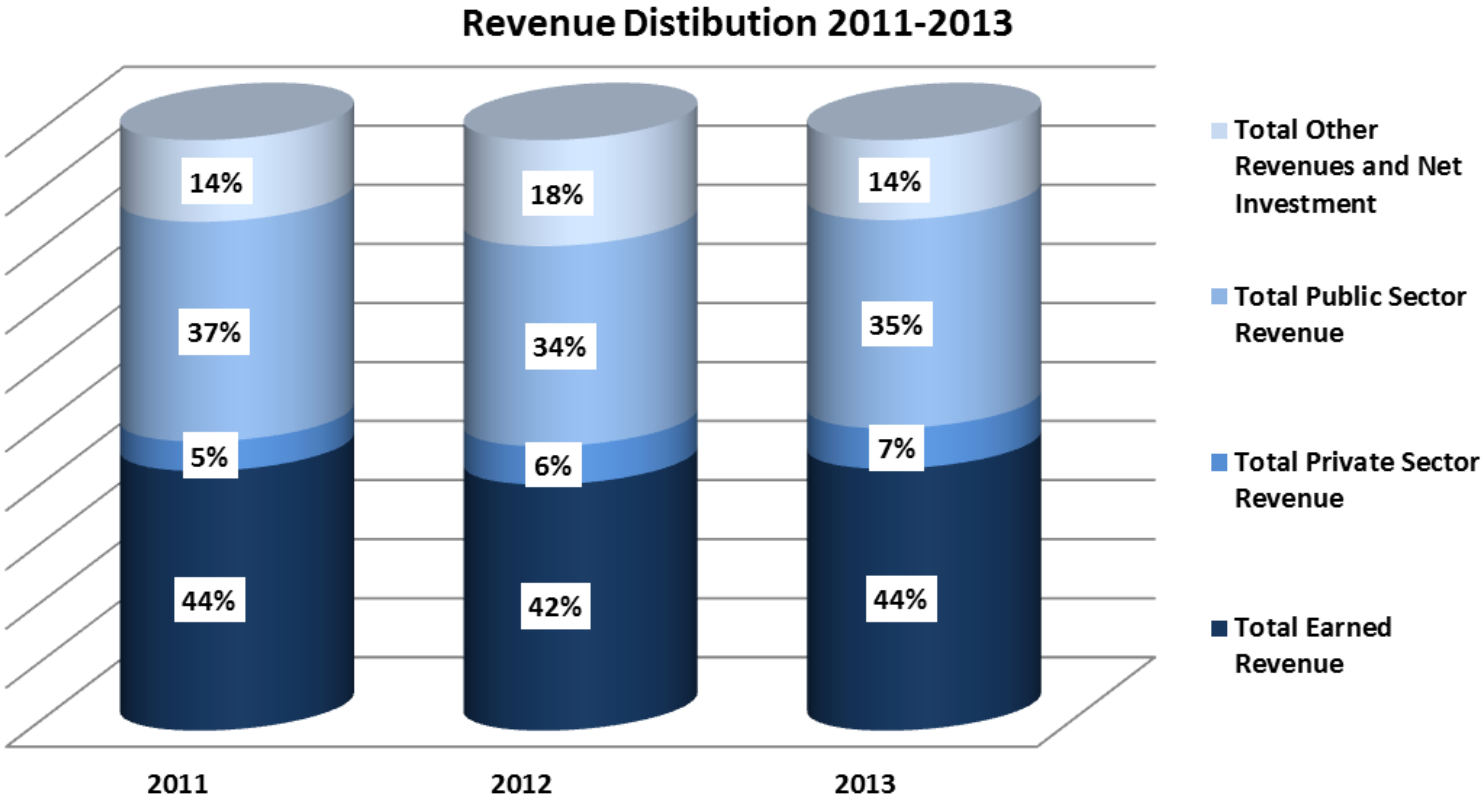

2009 - 2013 locked CADAC data, in \$millions



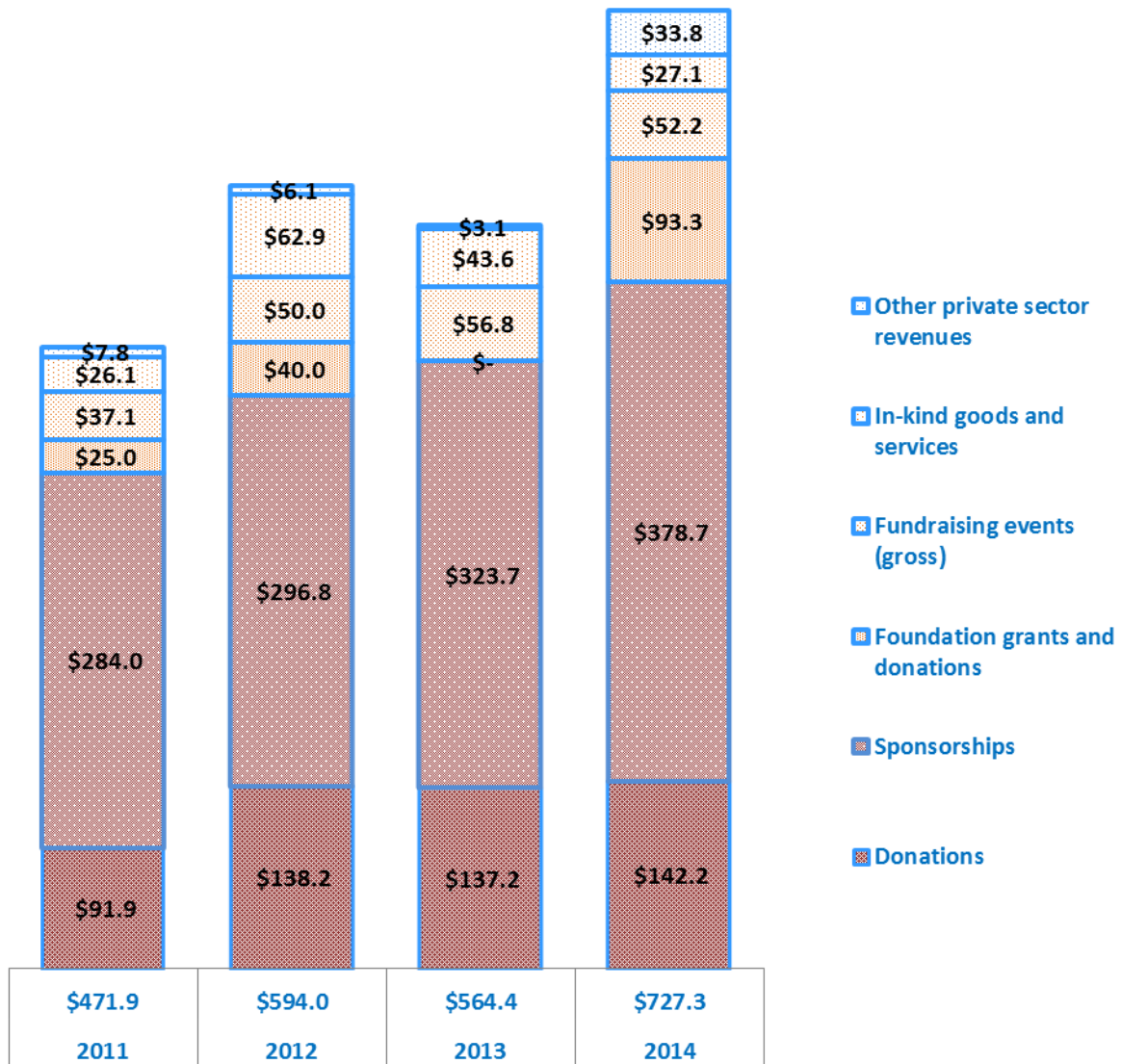

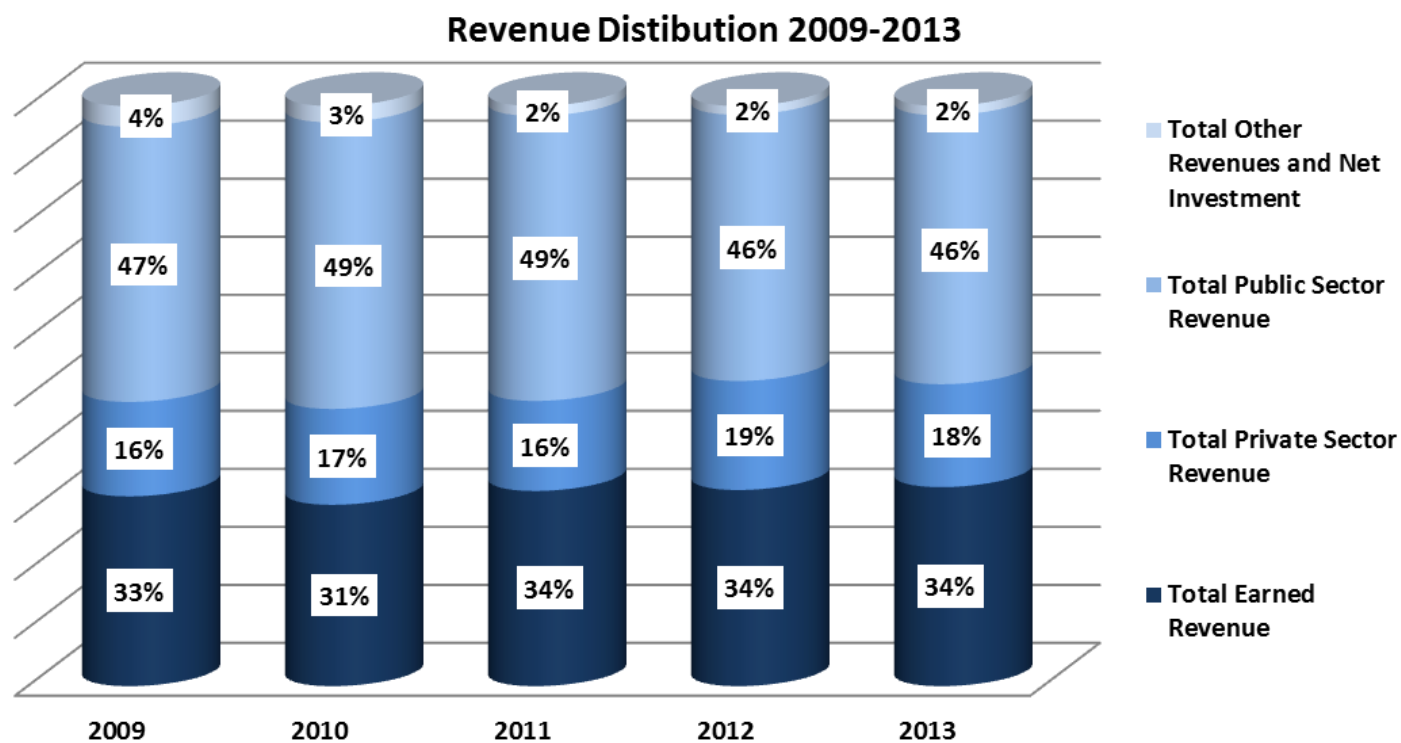

2009 - 2013 locked CADAC data, in \$thousands



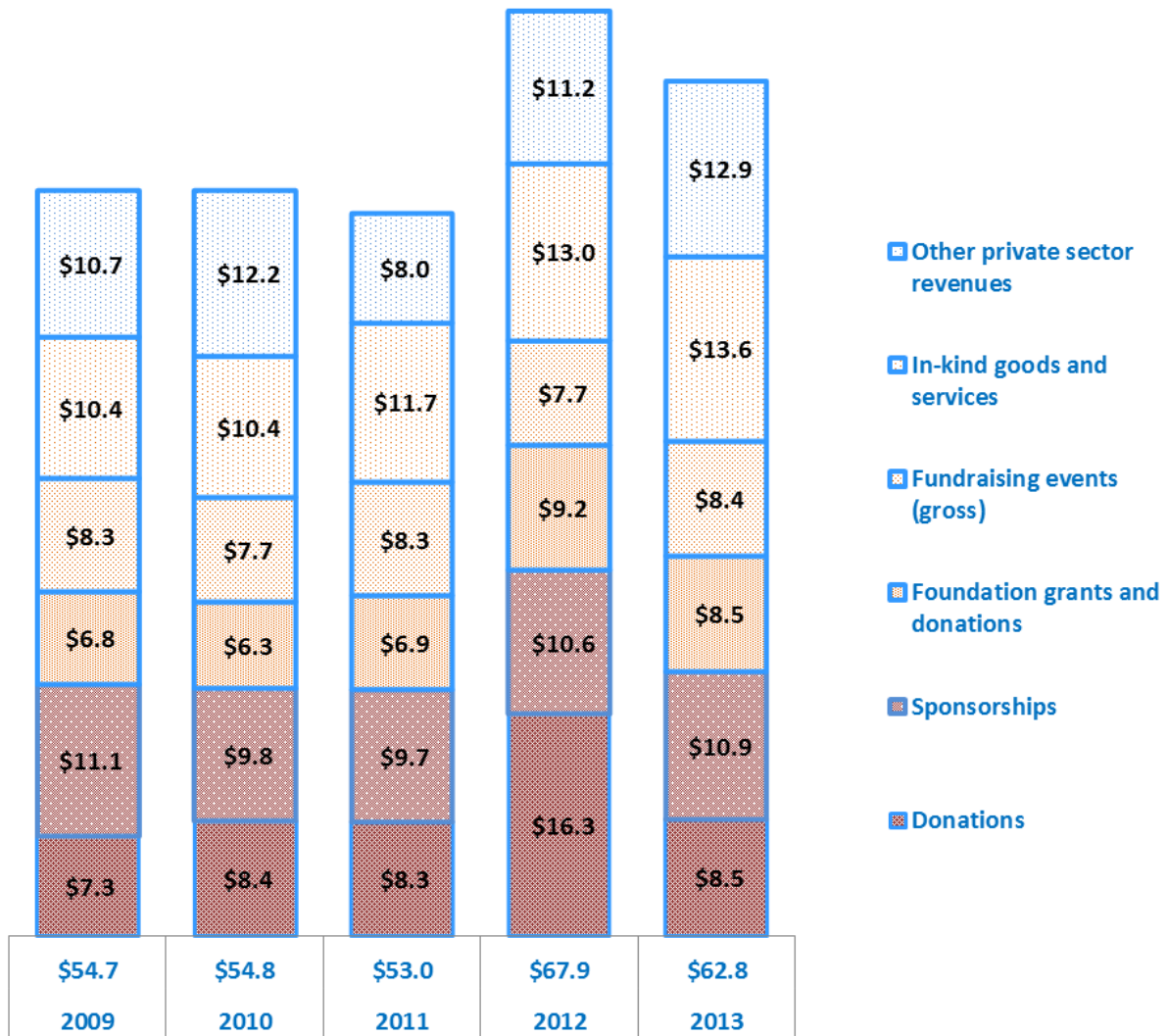

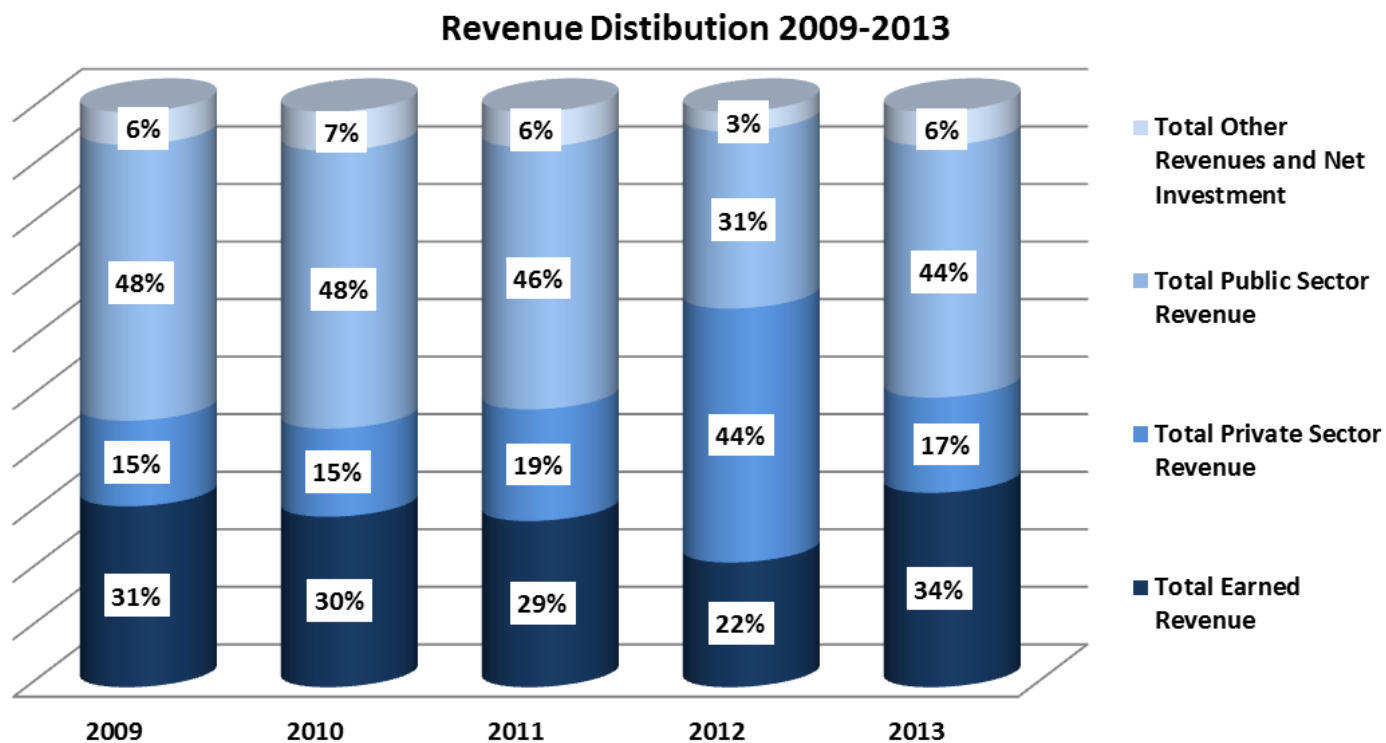

2009 - 2013 locked CADAC data, in \$millions



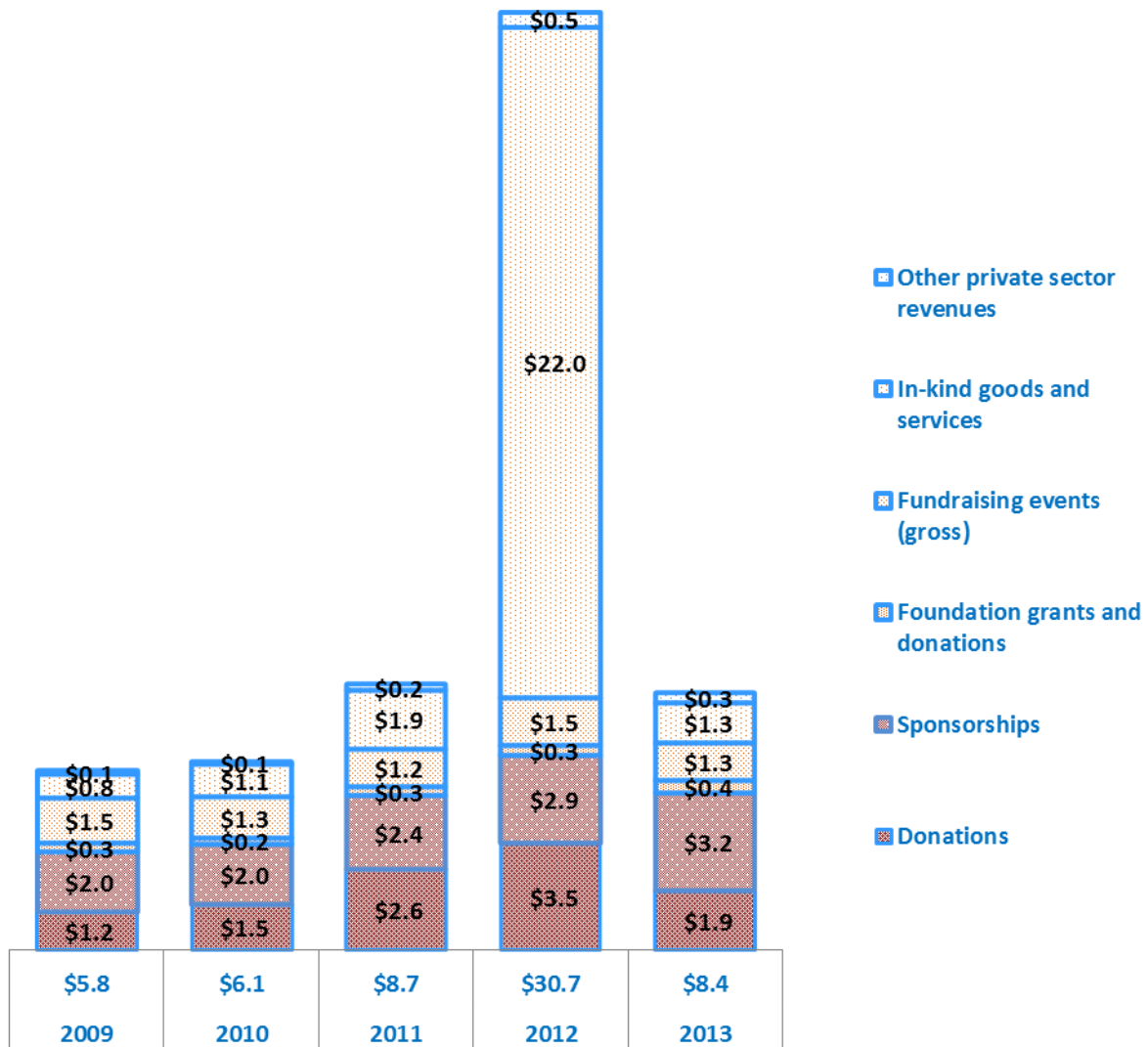

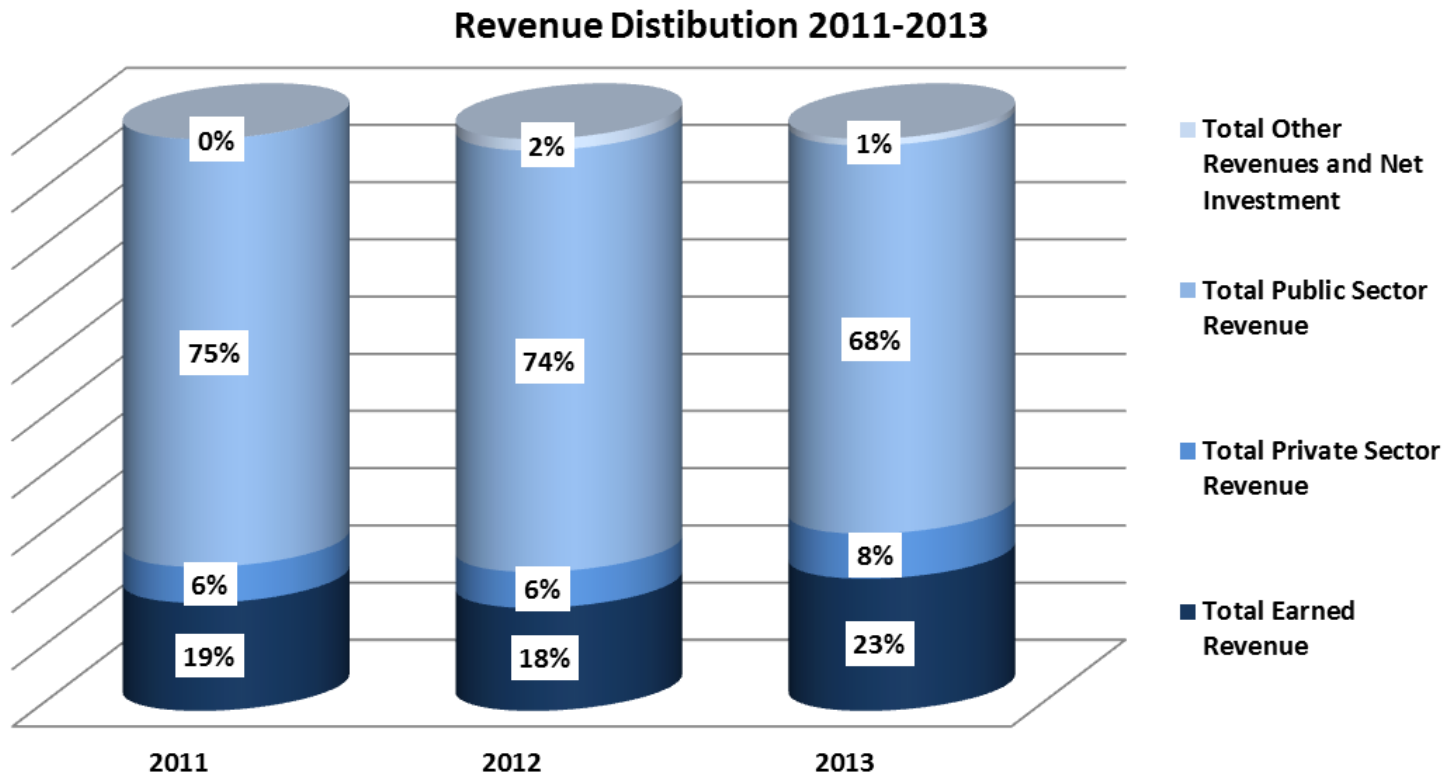
Breakdown of Private Revenues,
2009 - 2013 locked CADAC data, in \$millions



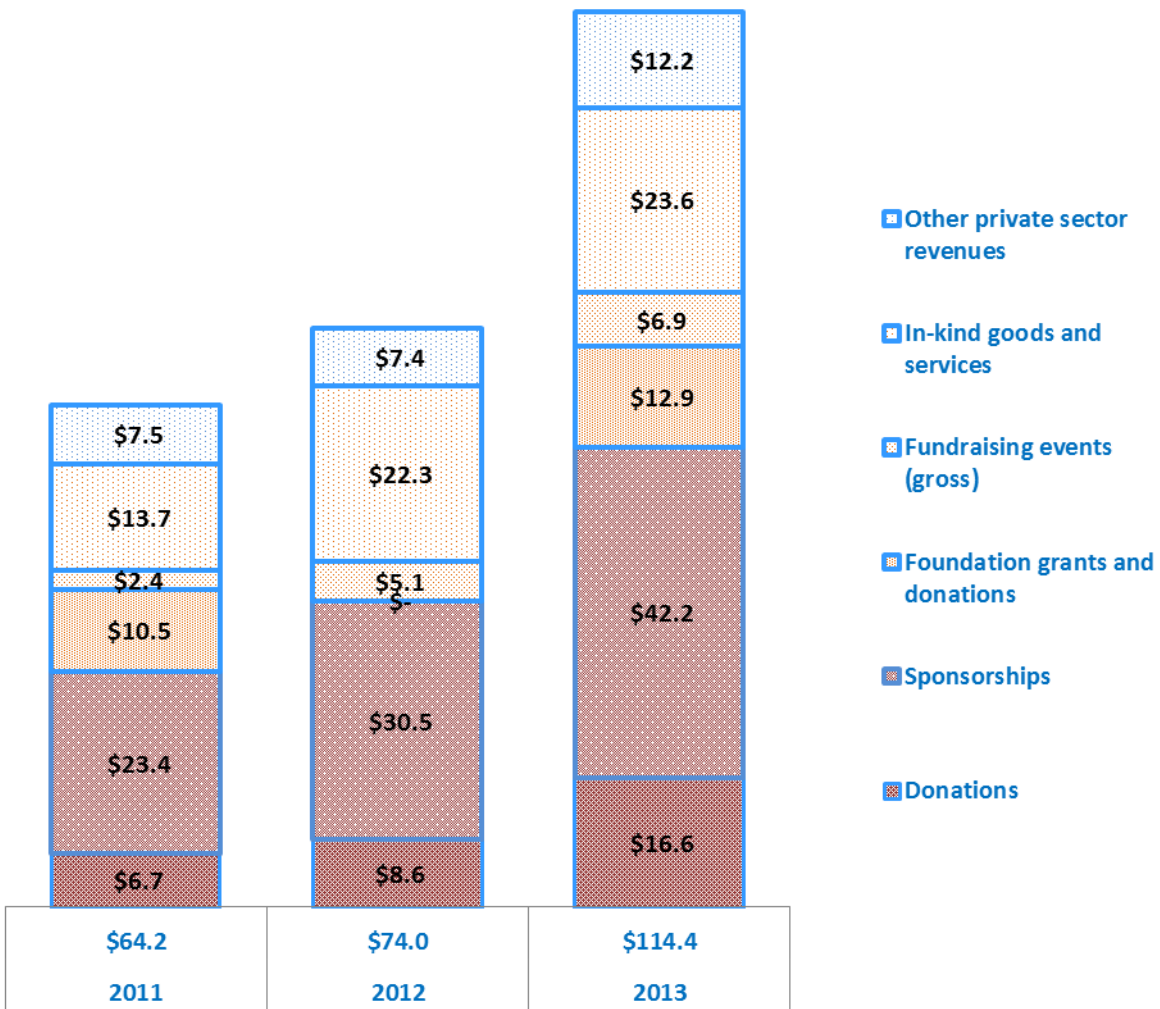

Notes

1. CADAC is a web-based integrated financial and statistical system for Canadian arts organizations applying for operating funding which allows the Canada Council and other public funders to collect and share common financial and statistical data. The data was captured September 9, 2014.

CADAC partners include provincial, territorial and municipal arts funders. They are the British Columbia Arts Council, the City of Vancouver, the Alberta Foundation for the Arts, the Edmonton Arts Council, the Saskatchewan Arts Board, the City of Saskatoon, the Manitoba Arts Council, the Ontario Arts Council, the Toronto Arts Council, the City of Toronto Culture Division, the City of Greater Sudbury, the City of Kingston Arts Fund, the New Brunswick Arts Development Branch / Department of Tourism, Heritage and Culture, the Newfoundland and Labrador Arts Council and the Canada Council for the Arts.

Methodology:

- This report includes locked data only from 2008-09 to 2013-14
- As Quebec is not a partner there is a gap in data from this province. This said, the Canada Council for the Arts funds Quebec-based organizations, therefore, the data does include statistics from Quebec. The majority of Quebec dance companies that receive Canada Council operating grants also receive operating grants through the Conseil des arts et des lettres du Québec (CALQ).
- “Breakdown of Private Revenues”:
 - Donations item includes Individual (line 4305) and Corporate donations (line 4310);
 - Sponsorship includes General corporate sponsorships (line 4315) and Specific corporate sponsorships (line 4320).
- For confidentiality reasons, the report includes only provinces/territories and years with more than five organizations.
