
## Canada's Anti-Spam Law: Commercial Electronic Message (C.E.M.) Process Chart

(CASL C.E.M. provisions come into force July 1, 2014)

<sup>\*\*\*</sup>Name(s); mailing address; either a phone number, web address or email address; statement re on whose behalf C.E.M. sent; and the required unsubscribe mechanism 6(2)c, C2, C3.
