No estimates of fewer than 500 artists are provided in this report because of concerns over data reliability. Prince Edward Island, the Yukon, Northwest Territories, and Nunavut each have reportedly fewer than 500 artists. There are 6,700 artists in the Atlantic provinces who spent more time at their art than at any other occupation in May of 2011. Artists in the four Atlantic provinces comprise 5% of all Canadian artists, compared with 7% of the nation's overall labour force. There are 560 artists in the three territories who spent more time at their art than at any other occupation in May of 2011. The three territories account for 0.4% of Canada's artists.
